

The Priestley Centre layby from Coniston

Directions to Priestley Centre (LA21 8AX)

A593 To: Windermere, Bowness and Ambleside

Coniston

B5285 To: East side of Coniston Water and Hawkshead

Toilets nearby? Private Toilets available at the Priestley Centre

Local Amenities:
Torver 0.5 miles, Wilsons Arms Pub and Deli.
Coniston 2 miles, village shops, café's, cash machine, petrol station.

A593 To: Barrow, A590 and the Furness Peninsula

*From the North M6 via Ambleside, A593 and Coniston

Go down the M6 to junction 40. Turn right onto the A66 and follow until Windermere A591 is signposted to the left, just before Keswick. Follow the A591 all the way into and through Ambleside. As you come out of the shops there is a BP petrol station and the road splits into 2 lanes, follow the right hand lane and turn right, signposted to Coniston A593. Once you've left Ambleside you're on the A593 and this takes you all the way into Coniston. As you go into the centre of the village, you will go over a humpbacked bridge and then past a BP Garage. Follow the narrow road out of Coniston village for about 2 miles until you pass Wheelgate Country Cottages, go round the corner and then meet in a large layby on the left immediately after The Old Rectory sign-post. There is a red post box in the layby too. If you go over a humpback bridge, and can see Torver church you have gone too far.

Once you're there

Your instructor will meet you in the layby and take you down (in your vehicles) to the Priestley Centre.
