


Lowick Old School from Coniston

A593 To: Windermere, Bowness and Ambleside

Local Amenities:

Spark Bridge 0.5 mile, Farmers Arms pub

Greenodd 3 miles, Ship Inn pub, village shop, café's, cash machine.

Ulverston 5 miles, petrol station, supermarket

A592 To: Barrow and the Furness Peninsula

*from the North via Ambleside, A593 and Coniston

Go down the M6 to junction 40. Turn right onto the A66 and follow until Windermere A591 is signposted to the left, just before Keswick. Follow the A591 all the way into and through Ambleside. As you come out of the shops there is a BP petrol station and the road splits into 2 lanes, follow the right hand lane and turn right, signposted to Coniston A593. Leave Ambleside on the A593 to Coniston. On reaching Coniston continue through the village on the A593 towards Torver. The lake should be on your left. After approx 2 miles, you will reach Torver. Take the left turn onto the A5084, signposted Lancaster and Greenodd opposite the Wilson Arms pub. Follow this road for about 6 miles until you reach a T junction, turn right joining the A5092 towards Broughton and Millom. The school is roughly half a mile up this road on the righthand side. As you reach the rise of the hill there is a sign warning that there is a right hand turn coming up and it says SLOW in the road. The school is ahead of you on the right. Start indicating here and, as this road is very busy, we advise coming to a complete stop before turning because it is difficult to see the oncoming traffic. There is a sign saying 'Lane End - do not follow Sat Nav' just after the entrance and then about a mile further on you will reach a village called Woodgate so if you reach here you have gone a little too far.
